How to play – TIME'S UP! – Rules of the game

Time's up is a party game for teams of two players.

The same set of **20 famous maths words** is used for each of three rounds. In each round, one member of a team (the cluegiver) tries to get his teammate (the guesser) to guess as many words as possible in **30 seconds**.

- In Round 1 Cluegiver can say anything, but passing is not allowed.
- In Round 2 Cluegiver can say only one word, 1 guess only, passing allowed.
- In Round 3 Cluegiver can't say anything. Only mimes and sounds, 1 guess only, passing allowed.

Marking scheme:

Your final team mark is the total number of words discovered by your team.

Be careful: each French word you pronounce will take 0.5 point to the team.
