

Back-to-the-board

A student (the guesser) sits on a chair with his back to the board ; the other students (the clue givers) surround him.

The teacher writes a word (or an expression) on the board; everyone can read it except the student facing away from the board and no one is allowed to say or even whisper it.

Each student takes a turn giving a definition or a clue about the word, and the student looking away from the board tries to guess the word .

No part of the expression, description letter by letter or syllable by syllable, or drawing is allowed in the clue !

When the word is guessed, another student takes their turn guessing and another word is written .
